Dark red line indicates final  
stretch, where celebrations  
continue in the Cross Keys  
Inn and the other hostleries  
where the festive spirit can  
still be found

Yellow line  
indicates the  
"young mans route"  
to Pagie Burn

On arrival back in  
the village,  
'hospitality' of any  
kind; for a comfort  
break or otherwise,  
anywhere in the  
village, is always  
welcome

Orange line indicates  
the "old mans route"  
to Pagie Burn, starting  
at the top of Springhill  
Road, as well as the  
return leg of the walk.

celebrate the Pagie Water and the  
New Year, amongst other things
